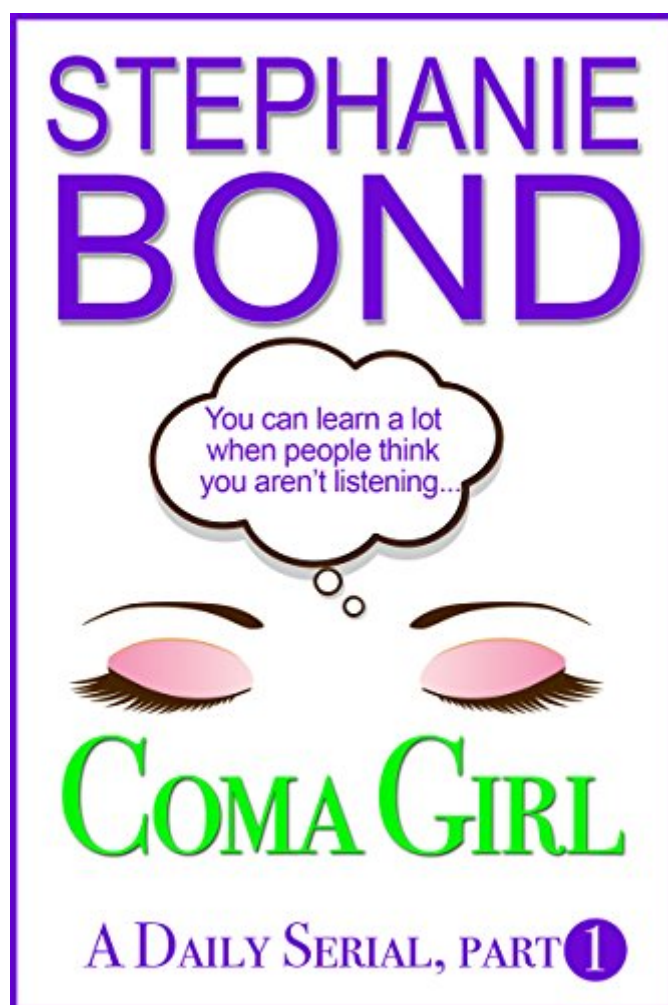


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Coma Girl: Part 1 (Kindle Single)

I was unsure what to expect when I read that the main character, Marigold, is unresponsive in a coma. Would the story be sad, melodramatic, boring? So far, itâ™s been anything but! Iâ™m ten days into reading the serial version of this story by Stephanie Bond and Iâ™m getting pulled in and

loving it. I love the parade of people who have come to visit so far and the sometimes awkward, sometimes painful, sometimes funny ways that families and friends speak their minds as they attempt to communicate in an unfamiliar situation, especially when they hope Marigold is listening, but aren't really sure. I love books with lots of dialogue and in this case the conversation happens between the doctors, nurses, visitors and the thoughts in Marigold's head as she struggles to regain consciousness before someone pulls the plug. I can't wait to see who will show up next. I still plan to follow the serial on Stephanie Bond's website, but I'm also buying the Kindle version so I can re-read the complete story all in one sitting at the end of the month.

Signed up for series and wasn't sure what to expect. Very pleased to say that I found myself drawn into the story and feeling connected to Marigold. Looking forward to the next installments. Sad, funny and the action told from the perspective of the middle child, not the pretty, smart one or the athletic, heroic soldier son. A story about a woman in a coma would be hard to write, but Bond does this effortlessly with humour and pathos mixed in good proportions. Marigold, hiding in her coma, is privy to all the things she didn't know about when she was awake - and some of the things she did! A middle child, she is used to being overlooked, but this time she is in centre stage and in spite of her perilous position, actually enjoying some aspects of it. I am sorry that the author doesn't like classical music. If I was forced into a coma, I would like nothing better than to listen to Mozart, Bach et al! There are many "laugh out loud" moments in this story, and to my utmost surprise, I am eagerly awaiting Part 2. :)

I really enjoy Stephanie Bond's writing and am waiting impatiently for Body Movers 8. Despite the off putting title and premise, I was looking for a little fix to tide me over until book 8 so I decided to try Coma Girl. I really like the story, so it's a five star review, and I also liked that Jack Terry from Body Movers makes an appearance, but I absolutely hate it being doled out in dibs and dabs. It's actually worse than waiting for book 8! Just when you really get into the book, Bam, sorry, you have to wait another month. I decided to wait until December and read the whole thing then.
