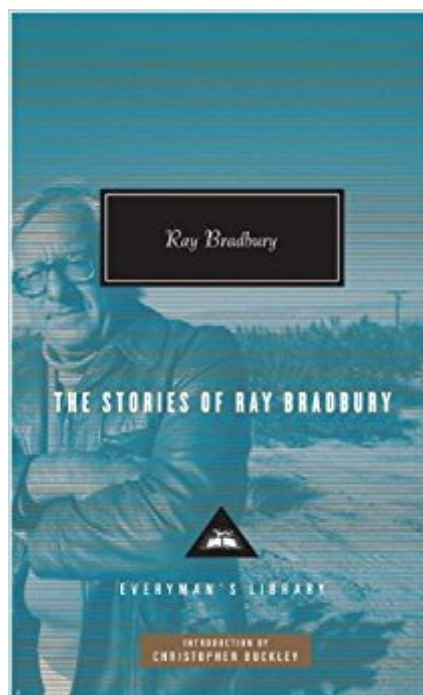


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# The Stories Of Ray Bradbury (Everyman's Library (Cloth))
